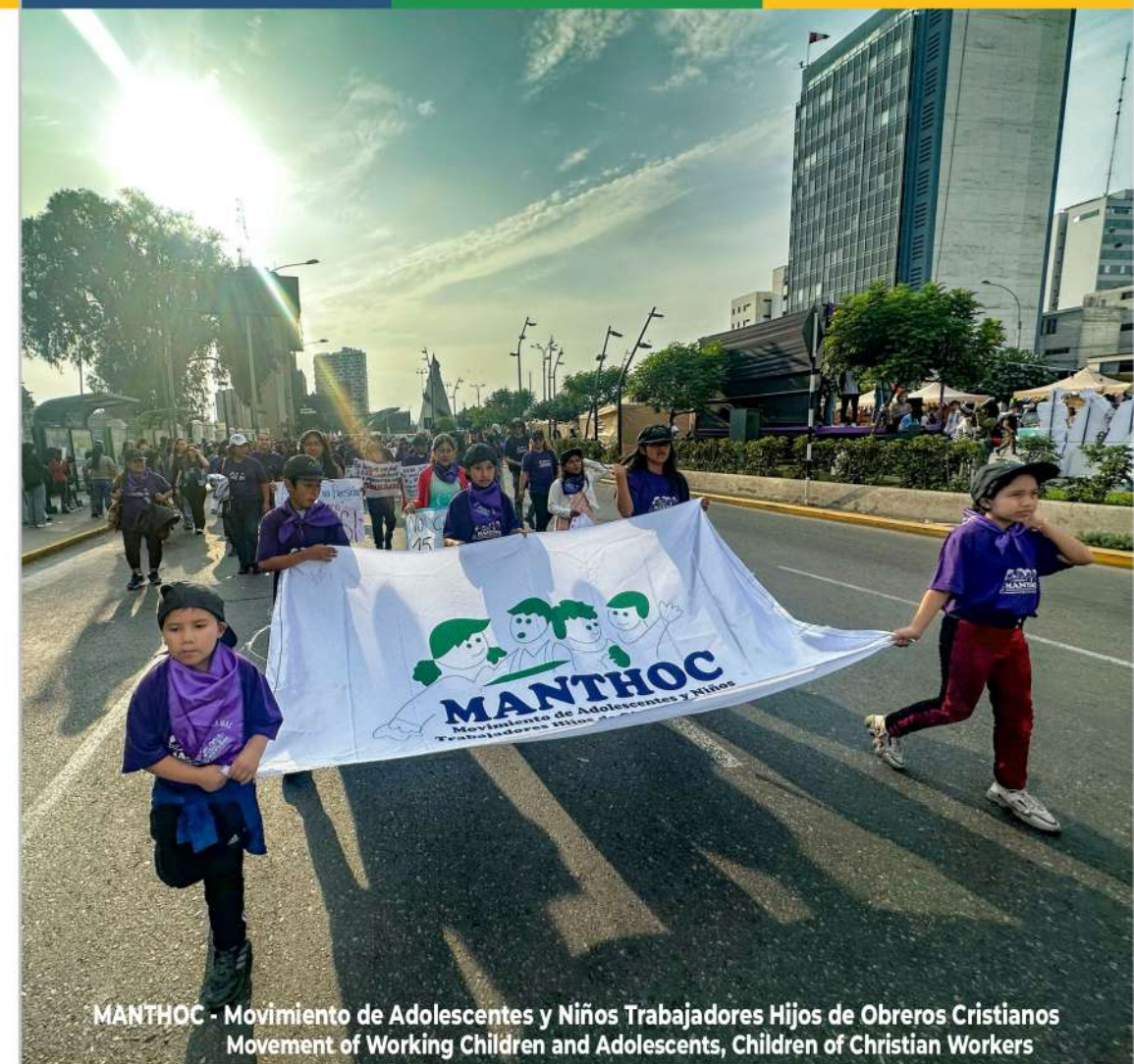

OUR HISTORY

The movement was born in 1976, during a period of severe deterioration of labor rights under the military government of Francisco Morales Bermúdez. The Young Christian Workers (YCW) in Peru promoted our organization by bringing together working children and adolescents from popular neighborhoods.

On March 15, 1979, we chose the name MANTHOC, with a clear principle: the organization exists to serve working children, not a group of adults.

In 1986, during a National Assembly of Delegates, we decided to expand our action. We began offering services in education, food support, health care, among others. This gave birth to the MANTHOC Association, which legally represents our movement.

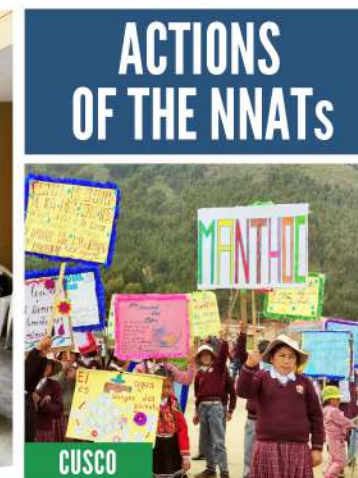
Our unique experience spread to different regions of Peru and inspired the creation of other NNATs social movements in Latin America.
